When is a CE mark necessary?

All products made available in the European Economic Area - including all products built for in-house use - must comply with the general basic security requirements of various applicable EU directives.

Who is responsible for the CE mark?

Here, the manufacturer of the product (*) is obliged to ensure compliance with the guidelines and safety requirements, to affix the CE mark and to draw up a declaration of conformity.

What is the CE mark for?

Frequently relevant EU directives are:

- Machinery Directive 2006/42 / EC
- Pressure Equipment Directive 2014/68 / EU
- Low Voltage Directive 2014/35 / EU
- ATEX Directive 2014/34 / EU
- RoHS Directive 2011/65 / EU
- Measuring Device Directive 2014/32 / EU
